We immigrated to California in 1985. She was a very courageous woman who truly believed that God can make things happen. She worked very hard as a nurse and worked long hours to provide for the family of five children. She has been married for 50 years to my father, Elviro Belocura. She pushed us to have high goals for ourselves, especially in education. She loved flowers, especially orchids and tropical plants. She can revive almost any dying plant. She had a green thumb. She enjoyed being in her garden for hours. She is loved by many friends and family. Often the stories that I hear is that my mom prayed for others and encouraged her friends, coworkers, relatives and whoever came to her - Not to lose hope and to keep praying! She worked as a nurse until 2010 when her heart and her kidney were failing. By the grace of God, she healed from a big heart surgery in 2011 and on Thanksgiving eve in 2011 she received a kidney transplant. The kidney was intended to last 3 years but God blessed her with 11 years instead. She spent her last 11 years being a grandmother to 10 grandchildren and enjoying them as much as she can. She worried about everyone else before herself. She is often praying her Novenas at specific times of the day. My mother is a walking miracle! Her life is a testimony of how God is loving, merciful and faithful! I am blessed to be her daughter. Thank you for praying for my mom and our family!
