James Bryan Kincaid, a resident of Vallejo, California, passed away on 06/28/2023 at the age of 75.

The son of Vernon V. and Alma O. (Johnson) Kincaid, James was born in Jasper, Georgia on 07/04/1947. After graduating from Pickens County High School in 1965, James enrolled at Reinhardt College and Georgia State University before completing a Bachelor of Science in Electronics from Chapman University in 1987.

James was a proud veteran who retired from the United States Navy as an E-9 Master Chief Officer Electrician's Mate Chief aboard the USS Snook (SSN-592), Skipjack-class submarine, and the USS Tautog (SSN-639), Sturgeon-class attack submarine, serving his country in the active duty and reserves for 30 years, from 1969 - 1999. He also retired after 29 years from Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory where he was a dedicated employee from 1978 – 2007.

Bryan was also an avid deep sea fisherman, chartering up and down the coast of California and a member of The Hill and St. Catherine's in Vallejo.
