“Imagine coming from America then suddenly meeting so many fun and wonderful, cousins in the Philippines. Then imagine the additional shock of meeting one branch of the Sismaet Family that actually looked like the American classmates that I just left behind! Getting to know the Demers branch was one of many wonderful and unique things about living in the Philippines. When we visited Ate Nancy and Family in Quezon City, one of the first things I marveled at was the grass surrounding her home. It contained the makahiya plant which closes when touched. It seemed to me that everything about Ate Nancy was kind of magical. Aside from her unique grass, I had never seen the kind of modern and beautiful home that she created for her family. I had also never seen or heard anyone play an organ with all the pedals and knobs that Ate Nancy expertly pushed and pulled while playing the keys. I was eight years old and couldn't even master a simple piano! Years later Ate Nancy and family visited our home in San Diego at Christmas. We thought it was cute that she gifted us kids with pajamas, just as my mom gifted all of her kids with pajamas! Great minds think alike and I always appreciated the bond between Ate Nancy and Mama that began in childhood. Mama is Ate Nancy's aunt and is two years older than Ate Nancy. Mama told us stories of protecting Ate Nancy from bullies when they were kids. They remained the best of friends through the years. The two of them went to dances together and both had an interest in the latest fashion forward outfits they wore to dances and day trip excursions. Kuya Romy or Uncle Rosing chaperoned them wherever they went. Mama even fondly remembered borrowing the photo coloring set owned by Ate Nancy, Ate Norma, and Ate Glorie's father. To this day, we have the photos where Mama hand-painted her watch gold, and her fingernails red, courtesy of the Demers family. In 2005, Ruby and I accompanied Mama and Ate Nancy to the Philippines. It was just like old times for them as they shopped, laughed, and rehashed stories of their childhood and youth. I remember seeing Ate Nancy appreciating our time in San Felipe when we visited my Dad's side of the family. Ate Nancy was so joyful and gracious as she joined in the reunion we had with the Farrales and Rosas family members. We also visited
