"Oscar Cruz Reyes was born on August 29, 1947 in Tondo, Manila, Philippines to Bienvenido and Angelita Reyes.

Oscar became the first in his family to successfully acquire a college degree, first pursuing a Chemical Engineering degree at Mapua Institute of Technology and a degree in Business Administration at the Philippine School of Business Administration.

From there, he played an integral role in computerizing the Manila Stock Exchange and applied his skills as a computer specialist for Aramco Oil Exploration in Saudi Arabia for 5 years.

Oscar then immigrated to the United States, living in Portland, Oregon and eventually settling in California where he took up trade as a licensed optician in Walnut Creek, CA.

He would eventually work at a group home for children with special needs as program manager in Hayward, CA where he met Chona Aquino, a registered nurse and his son's mother who passed away shortly after giving birth after a year-long battle with leukemia.

In 2006, Oscar started working at Copart as an accounts payable where he would meet many of his favorite people. He worked at Copart for more than

17 years, with no plans to retire because of how much he loved his job and the people he worked with.

Oscar was hard-working and humble, always putting his son and others over his self-interests. He was a survivor of many of this world's unforgiving challenges, but always found a way to smile through it all. He lifted all the blessings of his life to God. His interests included playing the guitar in his free time, eating, cracking jokes with friends and family, and spending quality time with his dog and his son.

Oscar passed away peacefully on Friday May, 27, 2023

He is survived by his only son Orson Reyes, his beloved dog Milkshake, his younger brother Herminio Reyes, and many nieces and nephews.

Oscar will be deeply missed, but his legacy of love, kindness, and generosity will continue to inspire us all. May his soul find eternal peace, and may his memory be a blessing to those whose lives he touched."
