Roger Lambert passed away peacefully on September 23, 2024. He was born and raised in the Biddeford-Saco area in Maine. He graduated from the University of Maine in 1961 with a bachelor of science degree in electrical engineering.

He was employed at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard in Kittery, Maine from 1961 to 1971 and later at the Mare Island Naval Shipyard in Vallejo, California from 1971 until his retirement in 1993. He was a kind, quiet, and generous man.

His hobbies and interests included model railroading, traveling by railroad around the United States, Canada, and Switzerland. He traveled very often to visit family in Maine and Pennsylvania.
